Grant Opportunities and Funding Options for Lake and Watershed Projects

This workshop will provide a broad spectrum of information related to grant opportunities for lake and watershed projects with Federal and State agencies. Representatives from Illinois EPA, Illinois DNR, and Peoria County SWCD/NRCS will present attendees with a list and description of grant opportunities in their agency and related information such as tips for writing or applying for grants, application deadlines, contact information, website links, leveraging funds for match, and estimated funds available.
