1. Download Audacity at: <u>http://audacity.sourceforge.net/download/</u>



2. Open the original PSA in Audacity. Play the PSA to find the point where you want to trim.

3. Highlight the part of the PSA you want to keep and click the "trim outside selection" button.

- 4. Click on the time bar at the end of the PSA you just cut.
- 5. Press the red record button and record your tag.



- 6. Under the file menu, click export as WAV file.
- 7. Convert the WAV file to and MP3 (using Musicmatch Jukebox or your default software).
