Daily business briefing: Report cites coal industry drains millions from Illinois budget

A report to be released Thursday estimates the subsidies Illinois provides to the coal industry is costing the state millions. The report from the Center for Tax and Budget Accountability and Downstream Strategies was commissioned by the Sierra Club, Prairie Rivers Network, Faith in Place and the Eco-Justice Collaborative. The study finds that these coal companies, some of which have more than 600 mine permit violations on record, take advantage of a relatively lax mine permitting process in Illinois to use dangerous methods to mine high-sulfur coal and export it out of state. ...
