In accordance with requirement 1a, VI in the "Final Section VI(d) Determination" portion of the referenced permit, enclosed please find our "project completion report" for the substitution of the right (down dry bank of the Middle Fork Vermilion River near our construction site. The report describes the construction that was performed, and includes many photographs of the construction in progress and the stabilized river bank after construction was completed. Finally, the project site looks very good.

I must bring to your attention that within one or two weeks after project completion, following site inspections revealed that many of the planted plantings were being attacked by beaver. In response, we returned an ERM contract beaver traps to remove the beaver from the project area. Although many plantings were eaten above the ground surface, we believe the plantings will recover this spring and summer. Our progress report required to be submitted by November 15, 2017 will document the condition of all plantings.

We appreciate the cooperation of the Corp in enabling us to move forward in timely manner with this project. Please feel free to contact me if you have questions regarding this cooperation.
