



GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

OVERVIEW

Green Infrastructure Grant Opportunities (GIGO) Program funding from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency can be used to construct green infrastructure best management practices (BMPs) that prevent or reduce stormwater runoff. Green infrastructure means any stormwater management technique or practice employed with the primary goal to preserve, restore, mimic, or enhance natural hydrology.

EXAMPLES OF GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE BMPs INCLUDE RAIN GARDENS, DETENTION PONDS, AND EVEN WETLANDS.

ELIGIBLE GRANTEES

Individuals, Small Businesses, Others, Government Organizations, Education Organizations, Public Housing Organizations, Nonprofit Organizations, For-Profit Organizations

FUNDING INFORMATION

- Formula: 75% Project Costs – 25% Local Match
 - Environmental Justice Areas: 85%
- Project Costs – 15% Local Match
- \$5,000,000 Total Funding
- 2-10 Possible Awards
- \$75,000-\$2,500,000 Award Range
- Indirect Cost Allowed: No
 - Design costs, up to \$50,000 or 15% of the total cost
- Project Match: Yes
- Application Due: 11/20/2024

 - Fiscal & Administrative Risk Assessment (ICQ)
 - Programmatic Risk Assessment
